Thirty students per year since 1997 (did not attend 2007 or 2010 due to weather).
Top 10 placing as team: 1998, 2000, 2001, 2002 (5th), 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2008.
Individual medal winners (top 3 places) every year AHS has attended.

DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY SCIENCE BOWL – high school quiz bowl competition

Five to ten students per year since 2001.
Top half placings: 2001, 2002 (6th), 2003, 2004, 2008, 2009

DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY SCIENCE BOWL – middle school quiz bowl and car design competition

Five students per year since 2006.
Fuel cell car race – 2nd place 2006
Academic quiz bowl – 3rd place 2007, 4th place 2008
